2018-2019 IBA Dues Scholarship Information

Program Overview:

This 2018-2019 IBA Dues Scholarship program has been designed to boost member morale and create a stronger connection between IBA and its members. The last thing we want as an organization is to lose a member because he or she never got an opportunity to make their dues cheaper. Therefore, we have developed a program that is competitive in nature, and that offers financial support to those who may need it. Furthermore, these prizes will generate significant savings for the winners while allowing them to take advantage of the member perks for a full academic year. The added beauty of this program is that it provides financial support to members along with great publicity for both the individual winner and IBA. The winners of the three prizes will all be announced at a General Body Meeting and via social media.

Awards:

1st Place = Free 2018-2019 Dues (for the entire Academic Year - \$70 value)

Honorable Mentions (2) = Discounted 2018-2019 Dues (for the entire Academic Year)

- This award will afford *a member* the opportunity to pay a rate of **\$40 for the full Academic Year**, which is a \$30 discount from the normal Member rate of \$70.

Scholarship Program Logistics:

This scholarship will include a short application (details below under step two) and a brief interview (10 minutes or less) with the IBA President (Prianka Sanghavi) and the Vice President of Operations & Finance (Tyler Welch). This opportunity is open to any IBA member, potential member or IBA Officer. Here is the application and award process for all applicants:

1. Receive an application (paper or PDF)
 - a. Applications will be available:

- i. At General Body Meetings
 - ii. During IBA Office Hours
 - iii. For download on the IBA website
 - iv. Via email request from iba.vpops@temple.edu
2. Complete all necessary application requirements
 - a. General Applicant Information
 - b. Short Answer Questions
 - c. Attach a current résumé
 - d. Verification, Consent & Signature
3. Submit application (paper or PDF) by **2PM on Friday, September 28, 2018**
 - a. Applications can be submitted:
 - i. At General Body Meetings
 - ii. Anytime during IBA Office Hours
 - iii. Via email (signature still required) to iba.vpops@temple.edu
4. Receive a confirmation email of your submission and an invitation to edit a document titled “2018-2018 IBA Scholarship Interviews”
 - a. In the email, there will be a stated deadline for scheduling your interview
5. Schedule an interview on the aforementioned document by the deadline (you will receive a reminder email 24 hours in advance of your scheduled interview time)
 - a. Please note that once the deadline to schedule an interview has passed, you cannot move or alter your interview time on the sheet without sending an email to iba.vpops@temple.edu to confirm a new or different time
 - b. All interviews will take place in the IBA Office (Alter 503A), unless arranged otherwise
6. Attend interview with the President and Vice President of Operations & Finance
7. Receive notice of your application decision
8. Confirm your acceptance of the award within 24 hours of notification
9. Attend General Body Meeting for presentation and picture of recipients

Other Important Notes:

- *This application is open to officers and members – anyone can win the three awards.*
- Regardless of whether the 1st Place winner is a member or an officer, he or she will be entitled free membership (\$70) for the full year.
- If a member is selected as a recipient of the Honorable Mention award, he or she will receive a \$30 discount to make their dues \$40 for the full year.
- If a winner has already paid his or her dues before scholarship selections are announced, he or she will be refunded the award amount.
- If a member is hoping to not pay dues until the end of the scholarship program, but there are events that require paid membership before that time, we encourage him or her to reach out to iba.vpops@temple.edu to discuss the situation.
